LOCAL RULES

- Out Of Bounds (Rule 27) (a) Beyond the inside line of any wall, fence (or the extension of such wall or fence)
 or line of white stakes and/or white lines with black tops defining the boundary of the course (b) The area of
 the Maintenance Compound (behind the 8th green) contained within the fenced perimeter.
- Lateral Water Hazard (Rule 26) All water hazards at The Glades are deemed to be Lateral Water Hazards and are defined by red stakes and, red lines surrounding water holes. Where no line exists, the hazard is defined by its natural marain. Note — The stakes are immovable obstructions and are in the hazard.
- Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2) The following are classified as immovable obstructions: (a) All stakes, roped barriers, tee markers, tee signs, rubbish bins, seats, staked trees, raised concrete edging, 00B stakes, course indicator signs, drain covers, fixtures relating to irrigation, electrical boxes, all buildings, and Pump Station shared by the 11th & 18th. (b) All Paths and roadways with artificial surfaces.
 - (c) Immovable Obstructions (e.g. Sprinkler heads) Close to Putting Greens Line of Play Interference -The Specimen Local Rule is in effect for line of play interference from an immovable obstruction that is within two club-lengths of a putting green, and where the ball is within two club-lengths of the obstruction page 146-7. Rules of Golf
- Moveable Obstructions (Rule 24-1) (a) Stones in bunkers may be treated as movable obstructions. (b) -Motorised cart directional signs.
- Ground Under Repair (Rule 25) (a) Those areas as defined by white lines, white stakes, or appropriate signage. Note: Garden beds are not to be treated as GUR. Play ball as it lies.
- Embedded Ball (Rule 25-2) (a) A ball embedded in it's own pitch mark (through the green) may be lifted, cleaned and dropped, without penalty, as near as possible to the spot where it lay, no nearer the hole. (b) Wheel marks and /or wheel ruts (through the green) are to be treated as G.U.R.
- 7. Distance Measuring Devices (Rule 14-3) (a) A player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3. "for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.
- 8. Accidental Movement Of Ball On The Green When a player's ball is at rest on (or has been lifted from) the putting green, there is no penalty if the ball or ball-marker is accidentally moved by the player, partner, opponent, or any of their caddles or equipment. The moved ball or ball-marker must be replaced. (Note: If the ball was moved as a result of wind, water or some other natural cause such as the effects of gravity, the ball must be played as it lies from its new location with no penalty.)

Course Etiquette/Player Information


- Proper golf attire must be worn at all times. No Denim please.
